Cumulative Science GPA:

All required Science courses must have a minimum grade of 2.0 (C) and the cumulative average must be at least 3.0 for the student to be considered for admission. Everett Community College posts student grades as letter grades, each of which has an assigned number of grade points. Please review the guide to calculating your GPA if you have any questions. Transcripts showing grades as numerical values will be converted to a letter grade according to the EvCC guidelines and given the corresponding number of grade points for GPA calculations.

PAX Test

The points for the PAX test are equal to the percentile rank of the student's Cumulative Score taken from the NLN Testing Services conversion table and then divided in half and rounded to the nearest whole number.

Degrees

Six points will be awarded for a total of one degree, Associate's or higher, regardless of how many degrees a student may have.

Please note that foreign transcripts, with the exception of those from Canada, must first be evaluated by an official foreign credential evaluation agency. The agency should be a member of NACES (National Association of Credential Evaluation Services). A "General Evaluation" is sufficient (no course by course evaluation necessary). For more information, please review the <u>foreign transcript evaluation process</u>.

Veterans Preference

Students who are Veterans should provide documentation of their status via their DD214 form. For assistance contact the EvCC Veterans' Resource Center.

Health Care Practice

Students requesting points for this category must provide a copy of their **applicable state licensure** (current or expired). For military healthcare practice, include documentation of the type of training and branch of service.

Time in Practice

Additional points for healthcare practice can be requested for time in practice (over 3 months, minimum of 16 hours/week). To request these points, students must submit the Employment Verification Form. Please note that we will not accept an Employment Verification Form if the licensure has not been submitted as well.

Financial Need

Points will be given for verified award letters added to a student's application only from the approved list of programs provided. **Award letters must be dated within 12 months of application deadline.**

World Language Fluency

Documented competency in a language other than English, 3rd party testing is required. Also accepted are Certified Medical Interpreter and ASL Certification. **Transcripts showing language classes from High School or college will not be considered.**
