The Board of Trustees of Everett Community College held a special virtual meeting on March 25, 2020 via ZOOM.

Chair Betty Cobbs called the meeting to order at 2:02 p.m.

Roll call

Present for the meeting virtually Trustees Toraya Miller, Bob Bolerjack, Betty Cobbs, Mike Deller and Jerry Martin. Also present: President Daria Willis, Recording Secretary and Senior Executive Assistant to the President Jeri Pourchot, Executive Assistant to the President Rita Belvill, faculty, staff, students, administrators, and community members.

Action Items

Review and Take Action on E-Tech Funding to purchase Chromebooks for Students

Dr. Daria Willis, president, shared with the Board that the need to move spring quarter courses to fully online, due to the COIVD-19 situation, has added challenges for students who do not have access to computers. EvCC had previously purchased 405 Chromebooks from the colleges' E-Tech fund and now needs to purchase another 700 to meet the demand. The ASB Senate met this week and approved \$175,000 to come from the Student E-Tech fund to cover the cost of the extra 700 Chromebooks. The fund currently has \$875.00. The college has already ordered and paid for the 700 additional Chromebooks, and is asking the Board for approval to reimburse the college with the Student E-Tech money. The college already has the 405 Chromebooks in our inventory, and IT is busy setting them up, labeling them and working on a plan on how to best distribute them to the students. The extra 700 are on backorder due to demand and should arrive in April. There is a possibility we may need to purchase more.

MOTION 07-03-2020

Trustee Jerry Martin moved to approve \$175,000 from the E-Tech fund to reimburse the college for the acquisition of 700 more Chromebooks. Trustee Bob Bolerjack seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
