

Persistence: Credits Earned

The following tables compare Everett Community College credit earning rates to an in-state peer college group.

In each table, the first column is the category. The second column is the EvCC three-year average. The third column is the in-state peer group three-year average. The fourth column is the gap between EvCC and the in-state peer group.

If IN is entered in a cell, it means there is an insufficient number of students in the cohort to meet the State Board for Community and Technical College's minimum threshold requirements for reporting.

Cohorts include all first time and running start students.

Tables one through five show the percentage of students who have earned 15 credits in the first year measured for the following cohorts: summer quarter, fall quarter and winter quarter starts from 2020, 2021, and 2022.
