

Fall to Winter Student Retention

The following tables compare Everett Community College fall-to-winter student retention rates to an in-state peer college group.

In each table, the first column is the category. The second column is the EvCC three-year average. The third column is the in-state peer group three-year average. The fourth column is the gap between EvCC and the in-state peer group.

If IN is entered in a cell, it means there is an insufficient number of students in the cohort to meet the State Board for Community and Technical College's minimum threshold requirements for reporting.

Outcomes are measured for the following cohorts: summer quarter, fall quarter and winter quarter starts from 2020, 2021, and 2022. Cohorts include all first time and running start students.
