### **POLICY**

When a health or medical emergency or condition renders a student's continued participation in college academics, programs, or services impossible, impractical or unsafe to the student or any member of the college community, the following rules and procedures around a medical leave of absence shall apply. The executive vice president of instruction and student services, or designee, is responsible for the administration of this policy and procedures.
