

Underage Admissions Quarterly Release Form

Everett Community College (EvCC) does not desire to replace or duplicate the functions of the local public schools or school networks. However, we offer the option to underage students who are still in middle school or high school and not in other approved "dual enrollment" programs, such as Running Start, to take classes at the community college. The release form allows an underage student to enroll at the college with the permission of their school administration.
