Supported English 101 courses at Everett Community College are designed for students who would like to enroll to complete their English 101 requirement but would benefit from extra instructor support to help them succeed.

Corequisite English 101/104 Courses for Summer 2024

Corequisite English 101/104 courses combine 5 credits of ENGL& 101 with 5 credits of ENGL 104, a college-level DTA-transferable elective designed to support students in successfully completing English 101. This linked course begins with a foundational skills recap to prepare students for success in ENGL& 101 and includes focused instructor support across both English 101 and 104. Concurrent enrollment in ENGL 104 is required and students **MUST** participate in both classes. Students may enroll with placement into English 98 or higher.
